Annual Parish Meeting 2023

Our Chair, Mark Jamieson, will host this year's meeting starting at **6.30pm on Wednesday 8**th **March** 2023 in the village hall. Representatives from local organisations are welcome to present to the meeting in person or to submit a written report to be read out at the meeting about their recent activities, future plans, etc.

All residents are welcome to attend and raise any concerns, issues, and provide feedback, both good and bad, and to hear the views of others.

Speed Indicator Devices (SID's)

The Parish Council has heard resident's concerns that many



vehicles are driven too fast and drivers ignore the 30mph signs. The Parish Council has

saved sufficient funds to purchase two SID's which will notify drivers of their speed on the B1190. We aim to purchase a SID for Mill Lane when funds permit. We will erect three poles in the village shortly.

The SID's have an extended vehicle detection range of over 300 metres and can be turned to face traffic approaching from either direction. The signs are powered by a solar panel as well as a backup battery for dull days. We are extremely grateful to Thimbleby Court for their generous donation towards purchasing these SID's. More donations welcome.

Royal British Legion Poppies

We hope you noticed the British Legion poppies which appeared throughout the village in November. The Royal British Legion exists to support serving and ex-serving armed forces personnel. We felt, in common with other villages and towns across Lincolnshire, it would be good to highlight the work of this charity whilst also supporting the community act of remembrance.

New Voter Photo ID



From 4 May 2023, voters in England will need to show photo ID to vote at polling stations. From October 2023 it will also apply to UK General elections. If you don't have accepted photo ID, you can apply for a free voter ID document now, which is known as a Voter Authority Certificate. You can apply for a Voter Authority Certificate on www.gov.uk or by contacting East Lindsey District Council. You do not need photo ID to vote by post. Apply early if you need to register

to vote or to get your certificate.

Elections 4th May 2023

All seats are up for election on East Lindsey District Council and all parish and town councils. Nominations must be in by 4th April.

Hallgarth Housing Scheme

We supported an open afternoon/evening on 23rd January for those residents interested in the proposal to transform the Hallgarth Farm site. Dyson Farms intend to reconfigure this site to provide 13 new homes in Thimbleby. The housing stock will be mainly detached properties with the potential for a mixture of rental and owner-occupier stock. This proposal is at the pre-planning application stage so if you have comments they can be submitted directly to Dyson Farms Ltd. If they submit their planning application to East Lindsey District Council (ELDC) the usual consultations will take place to help ELDC decide whether to permit the development and if any conditions are applicable. The current estimated build time will be for completion in 2025. All planning applications are published here

Fix My Street

Report all street, pavement, potholes, fly-tipping, and street lighting issues directly to Lincolnshire County Council or ELDC through the FixMyStreet app or website. It allows you to pinpoint the problem on the map and upload photographs and be kept informed of progress. Other residents can see what has been reported too.

Keeping pavements and highways clear.

Householders are responsible for keeping their own hedges cut back and fences secure to prevent obstruction of pavements and the highway. Lincolnshire County Council may take enforcement action for those who do not comply with their responsibilities.

If you are aware of any obstruction notify via FixMyStreet and please notify local councillors if the issue is not resolved. We are monitoring the recurrent problem along Church Corner



first reported by us in 2019. If any householder has difficulty maintaining their hedge/fencing let us know to see if we can provide help.

Farm Nature Walk

Last year Dyson Farms trialled a nature walk in the Summer which proved very popular with those who attended. It is hoped to repeat it again this Summer. The focus is on improving biodiversity
